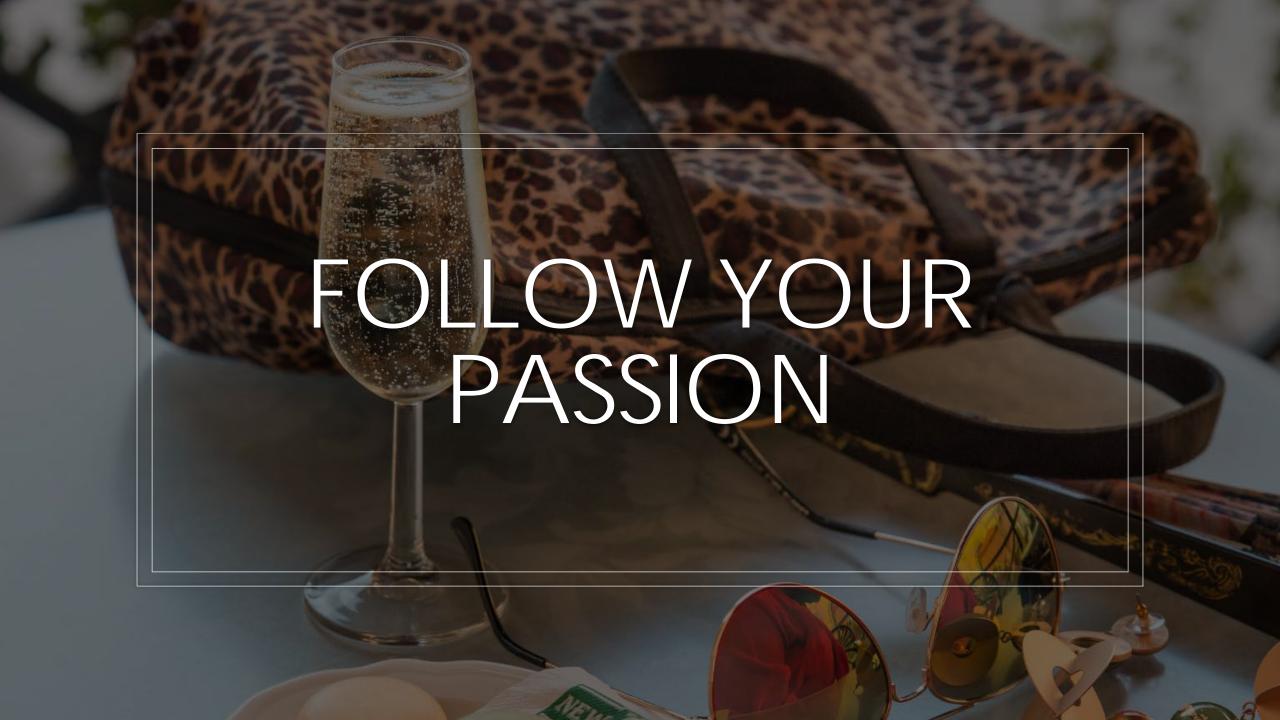
Don't try and fudge different elements together because it's cheaper. This is the opposite of creating a beautiful business and life that you desire.

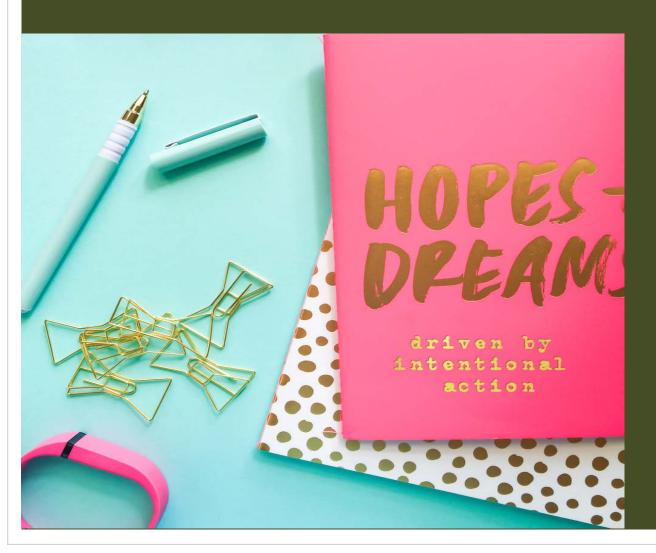
In most cases, they don't and you end up with lost revenues, upset clients and customers, and a whole load of headaches!

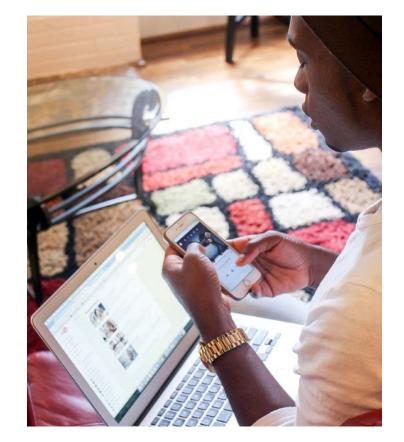




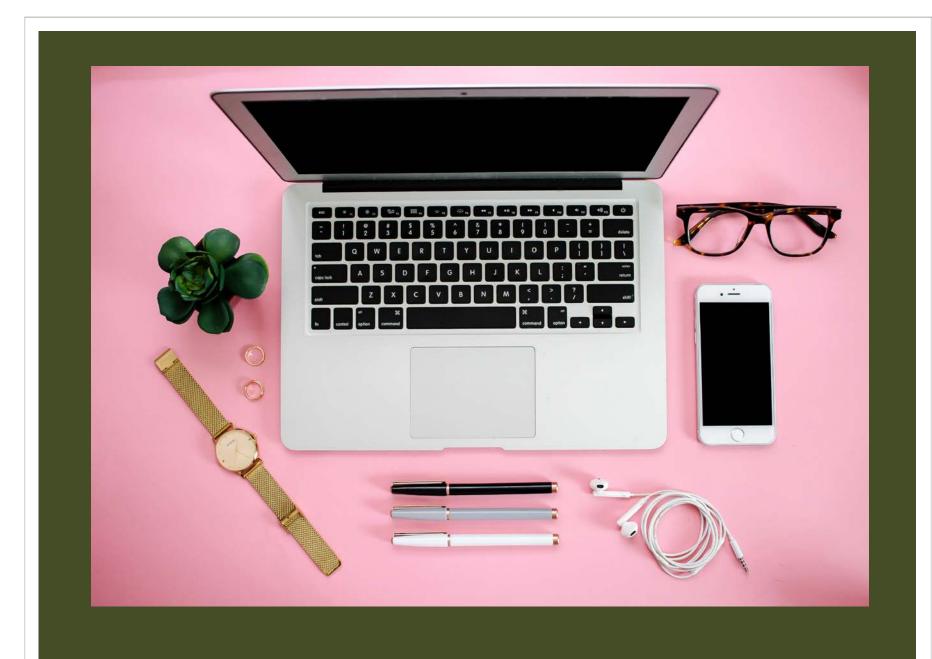
Get the right system for your business; not what everyone else is getting.

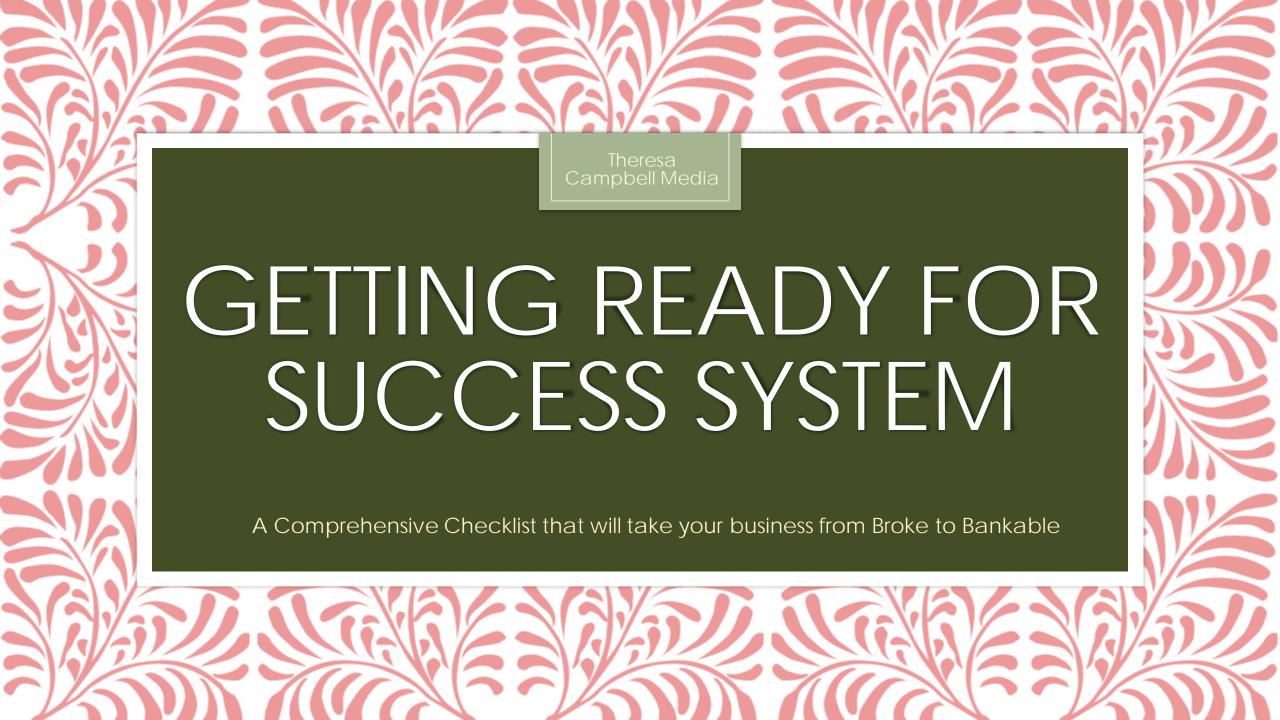






Theresa's Tips

- Use the mobile app Evernote to keep a record of your ideas. Link it to the desktop version. You can link 3 devices.
- If you are not able to type or write your ideas down, use Facebook messenger and send a voicemail to yourself (or a similar recording application.)
- Create your Standard Operating Procedures when you first start your business. Don't wait until you need one.
- Use bplans.com for inspiration regarding business plans.
- Know your business numbers. Don't do anything until you know how much it costs and how much you desire to profit. Learn the difference between "net" and "gross" profit.





Invest in a system for where you want to go, not where you are now.

If you're serious about your business, and want to be in the game for the long-term, then you have to be prepared to invest in the right ecommerce system for your business.

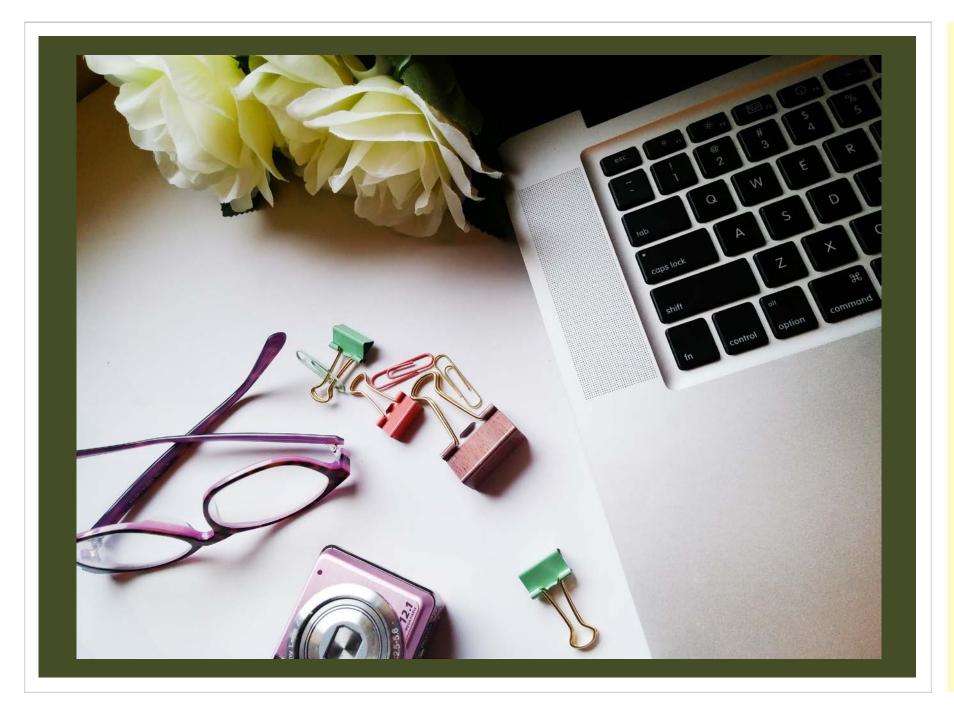

Theresa's Tips

- When you are first starting out, there is no need to pay for the most expensive software on the market. Learn your business first. Build as you go.
- Try to use software and applications that have mobile versions.
- Hire a virtual assistant, even if for a few hours a month.
- Use Fiverr.com and Upwork.com to hire experts to do most of the busy work.
- Keep your focus on MMAs ... Money-Making Activities.
- Create a project schedule for each milestone in your business. Don't expect to accomplish every task in a week.





"Manage" before you "Market". This simply means getting your foundational systems in place before you start to market your business.

Once you start to market your business and you're generating inquiries from potential clients, you want to be sure that you have the right system in place so that you can respond instantly and easily.

It also means ensuring your financial management system is organized, your inbox is not in a state of chaos, and you can easily locate critical data. Once you start to get busy, you simply don't have time to dig around for information, even if you do "have it here somewhere!".

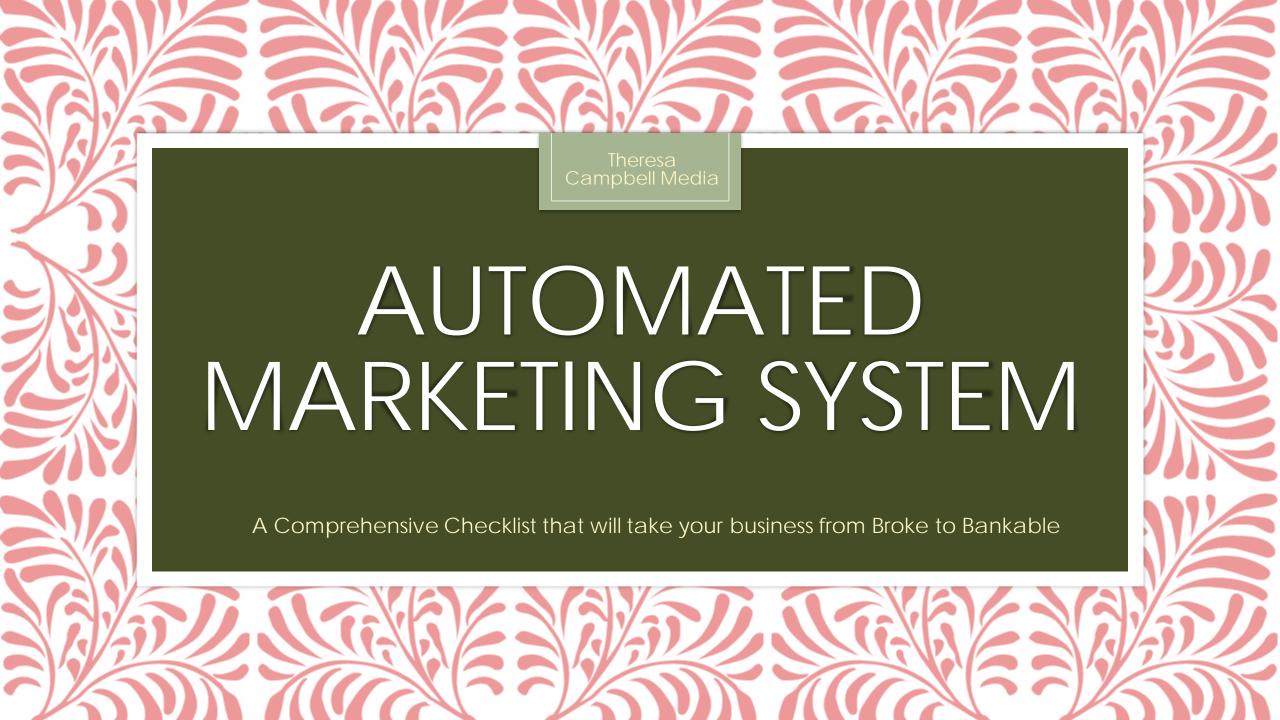






Theresa's Tips

- Purchase a professional email address.
 Don't rely on Google.
- Organize your files. Period.
- Invest in Microsoft Office. There is a monthly subscription plan available.
- Use Dropbox to manage your files and documents. Upgrade to the paid service. It will save a lot of time and headache.
- To get the most from software and applications, you will ultimately have to pay to play. Make sure to mind your budget. This is your Operations Budget.
- Allocate 20-30% of your Operations budget to software, applications and hired assistance.



Automate as much as possible. Any time you do "something" more than once, you need to create a system for it, so that doing it a second, third, or even a fourth time (and beyond) is quick and easy.

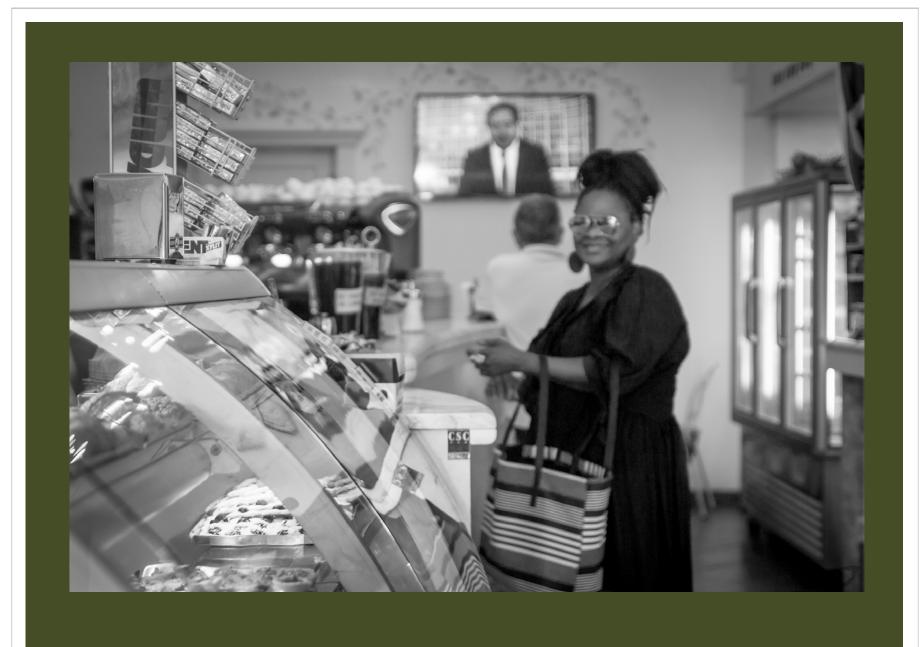
It's especially important to automate your online marketing system as once you start getting new subscribers on a daily basis, you want to make sure the information they requested is delivered to them automatically.



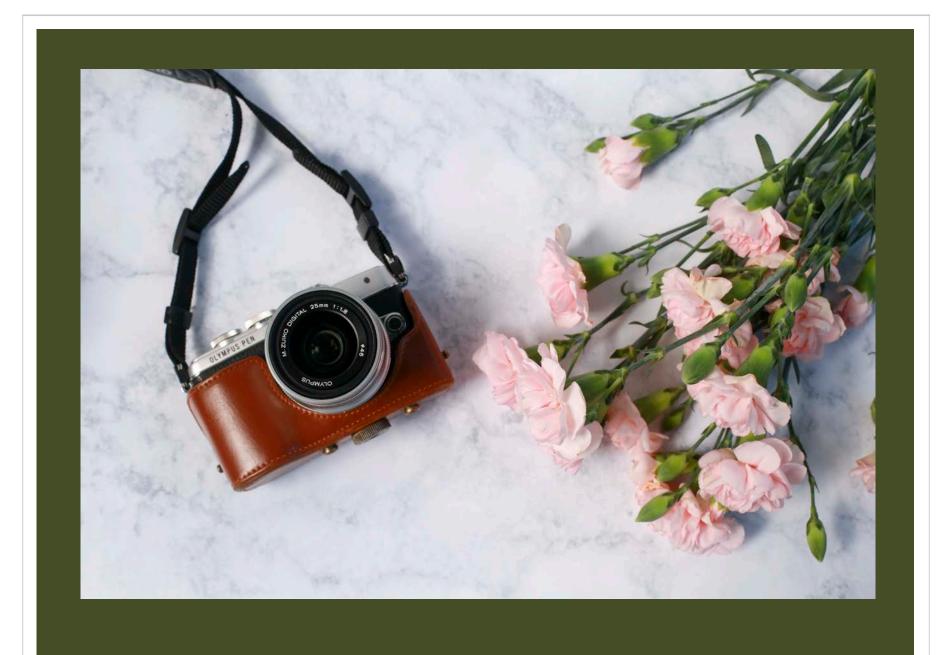




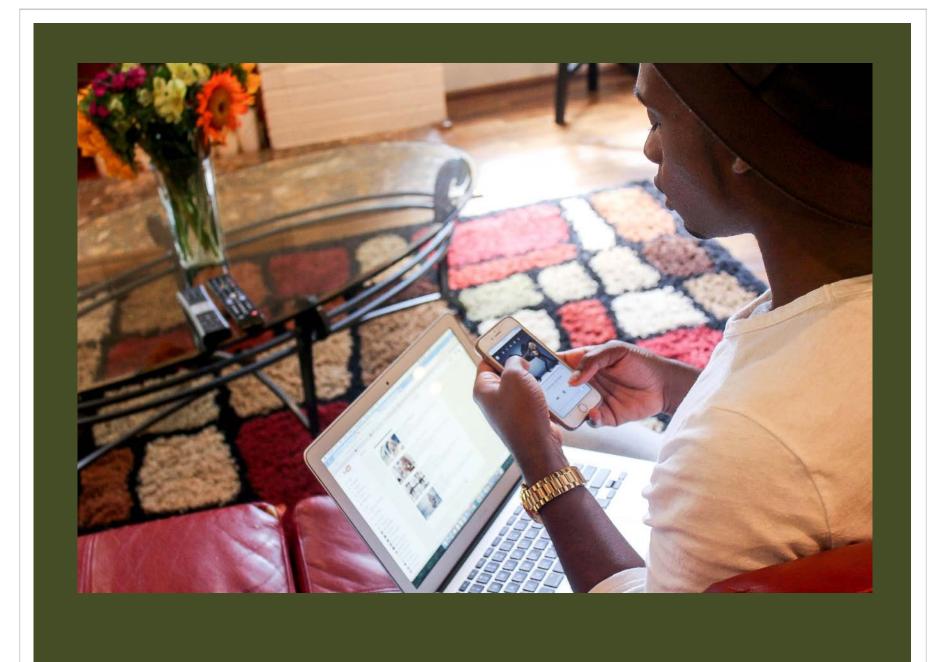

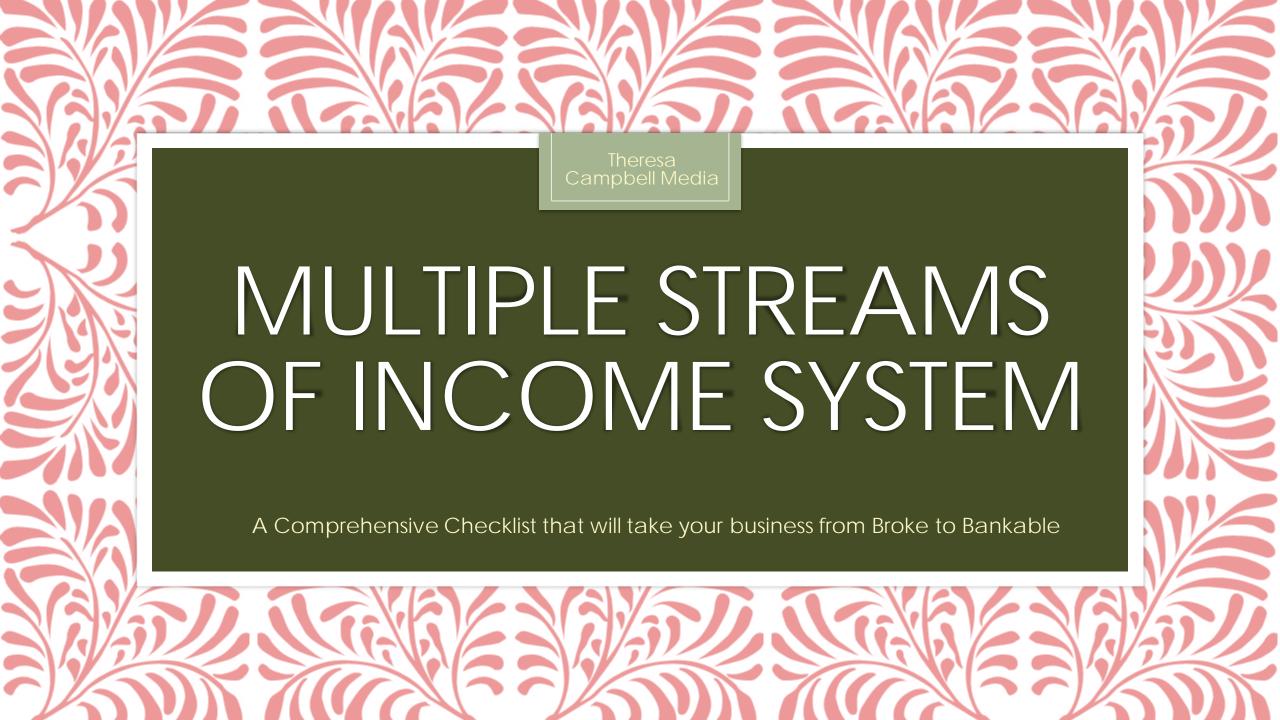






Theresa's Tips

- Invest in a microphone, lighting, backdrops, and tripod.

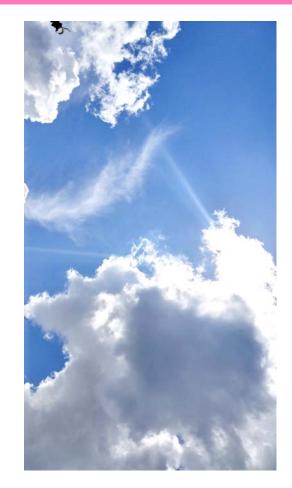


One more thing...
